INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT SYSTEM POLICY

1. PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

Naidu Consulting (PTY) LTD, herein referred to as "the Company," acknowledges the significant impact its operations have on people, communities, and the environment. 2. SCOPE OF APPLICATION

3. DEFINITIONS

- 3.1 IMS:** Integrated Management System - integrates all an organization's International Organization for Standardization (ISO) systems and processes into one complete framework.
- 3.2 ISO 9001:2015** Is the internationally recognized standard for quality management. It helps organizations of all sizes and sectors to improve their performance, meet customer expectations and demonstrate their commitment to quality. Its requirements define how to establish, implement, maintain, and continually improve a quality management system (QMS).
- 3.3 ISO 14001:2015** Is the internationally recognized standard for environmental management systems (EMS). It provides a framework for organizations to design and implement an EMS, and continually improve their environmental performance.
- 3.4 ISO 45001:2023** Is an international standard that specifies requirements for an occupational health and safety (OH&S) management system. It provides a framework for organizations to manage risks and improve OH&S performance.

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4. PROCEDURES

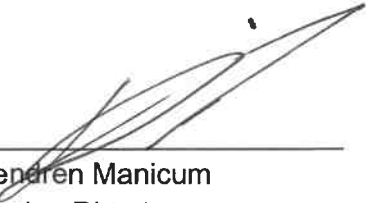
All individuals entering Naidu Consulting premises must exercise due care for their own safety and that of others affected by their actions.
